We had an excellent evening parent meeting this month. Thanks to those parents and community members who attended. We covered a number of topics:

- Tell Them From Me survey results: These are always pleasing for our school and this year's results were similarly pleasing. One area for development is finding ways to help our parents to provide at-home support for their child's learning.
- **C.E.C.I.L Skills**: Our school is working on embedding our C.E.C.I.L skills across a broader range of subjects in Year 7 to Year 10 in 2020. The C.E.C.I.L skills are <u>communication</u>, <u>engagement</u>, <u>collaboration</u>, <u>innovation</u> and <u>leadership</u> and these are the 21st century skills that are crucial for students moving into the workshop. Some of our reports will be updated in 2020 to reflect achievement levels in these areas.
- Parent and community business directory: We are currently seeking advertisements for our first parent and community business directory. Please contact the school if you would like to advertise your business in this publication for a cost of \$50.
- Attendance: We will have a renewed focus on attendance in 2020. A student who attends for 90% of their schooling from Kindergarten to Year 12 will have missed 1.3 years of their education which is an interesting statistic to reflect on.
- Homework resources: <u>The OzSpeller website</u> contains a list of 'Advanced' words which can be used by high school students to test their spelling skills and build their vocabulary.
- **Smiling Mind and mindfulness**: The school's welfare team will receive training from the Smiling Mind organisation in early 2020 on the use of their mindfulness and meditation app. This can be downloaded for free from your app store. The Smiling Mind website also has a wealth of resources.
- **Next meeting:** The next evening meeting will take place at 6:30pm on Monday, 3 February 2020 and our daytime meeting will take place at 9:30am on Thursday, 6 February 2020. These meetings are for us to share information with you and we benefit from these meetings just as much as you. Your presence and ideas are what we need.




Parent Survey



High School Reputation








Parents' Participation at School

Since the beginning of the school year, how often have you talked with a teacher about your child's learning or behaviour?



- 200 school days each year

- 2600 school days in total (200 x 13)
- 90% attendance = 2340 out of 2600 days

90% attendance means 260 days or 1.3 years of education would be missed


