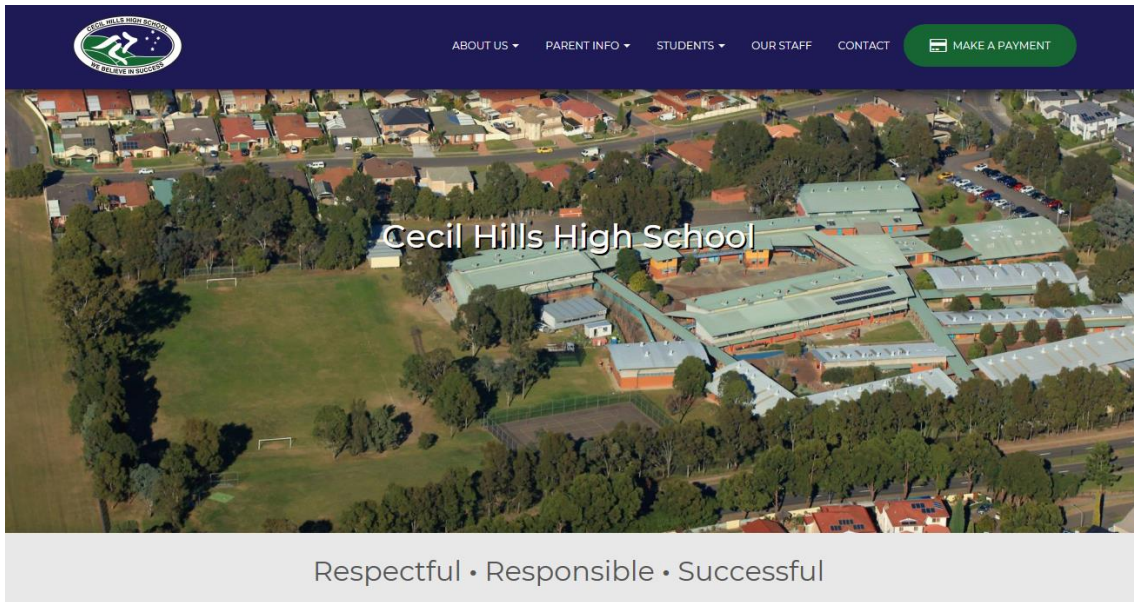

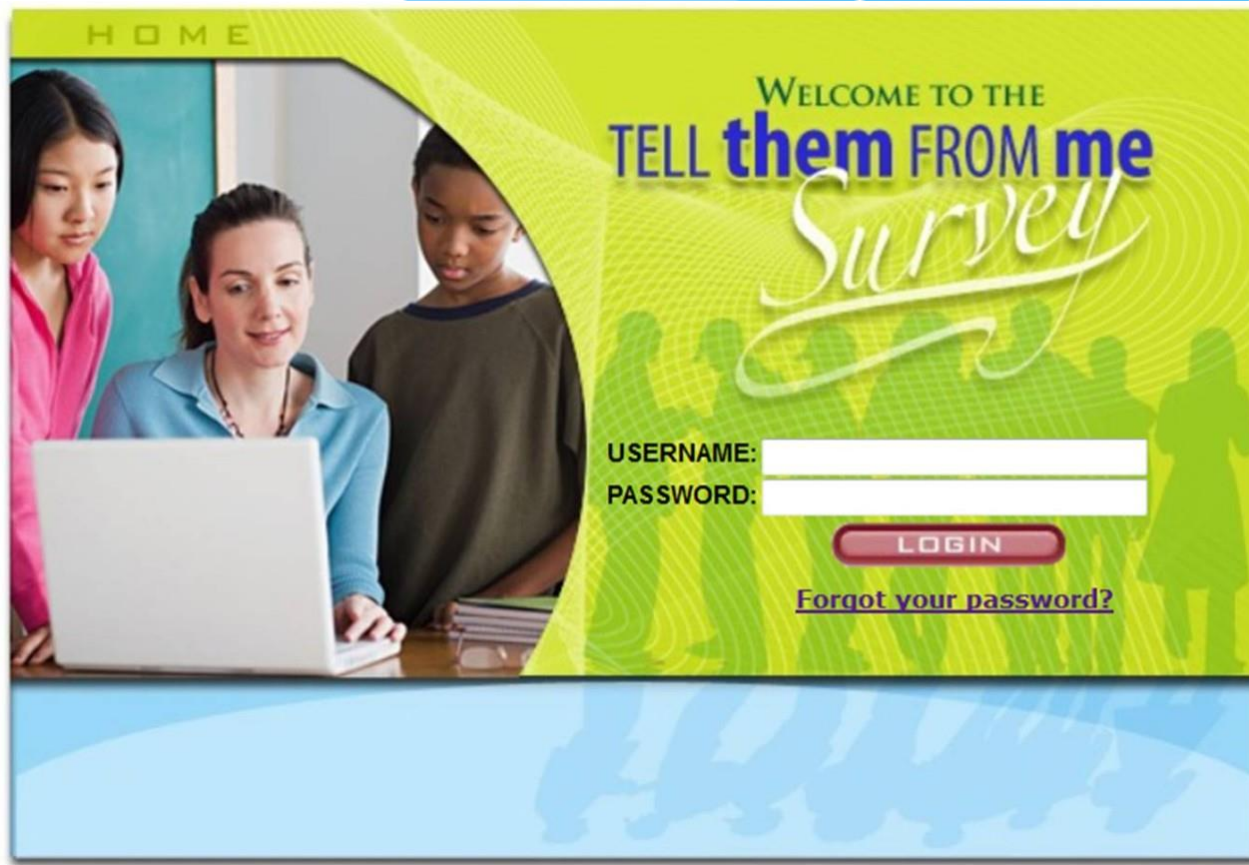

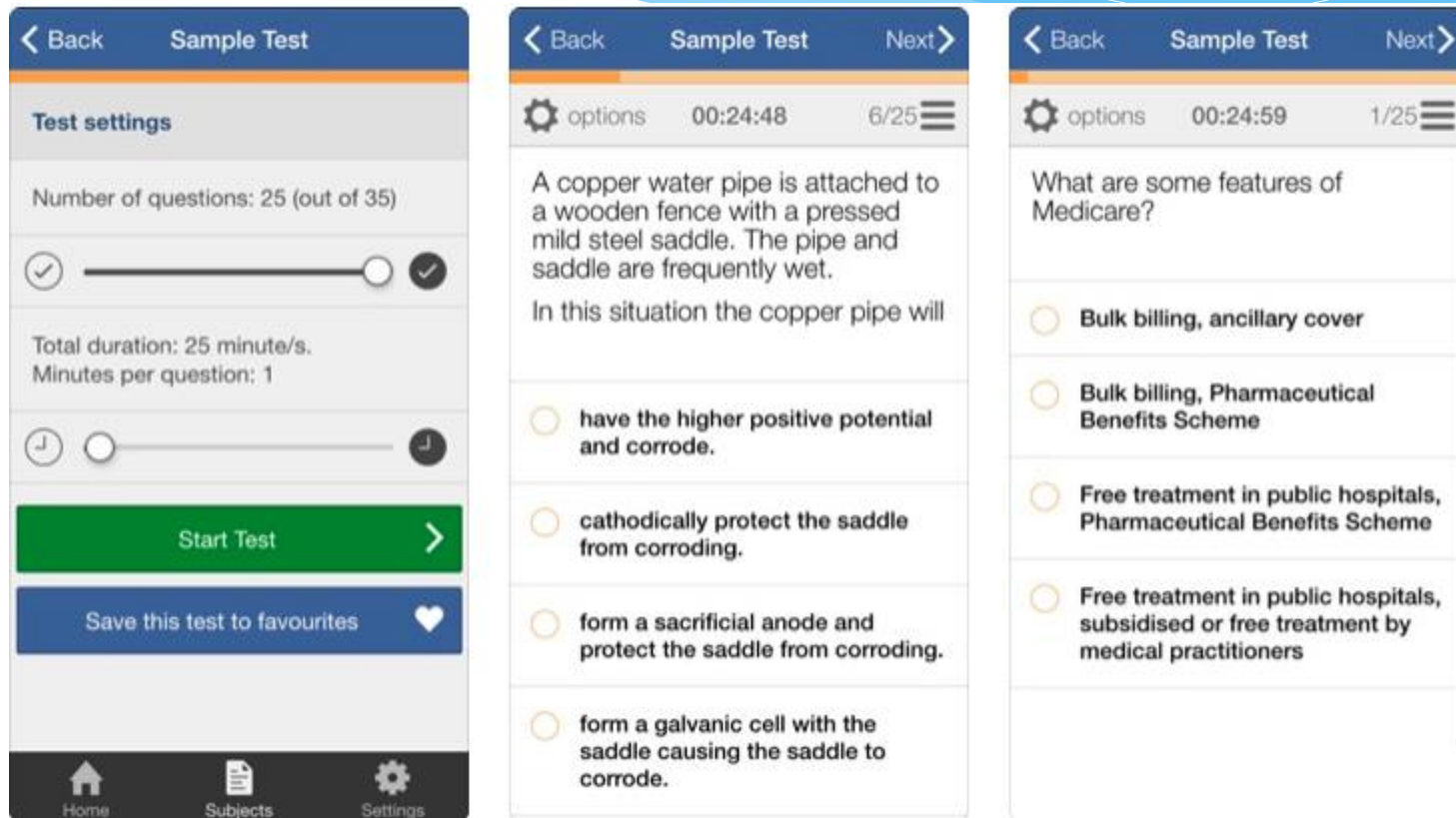

- Try flash cards, flow charts, mind maps and teamwork

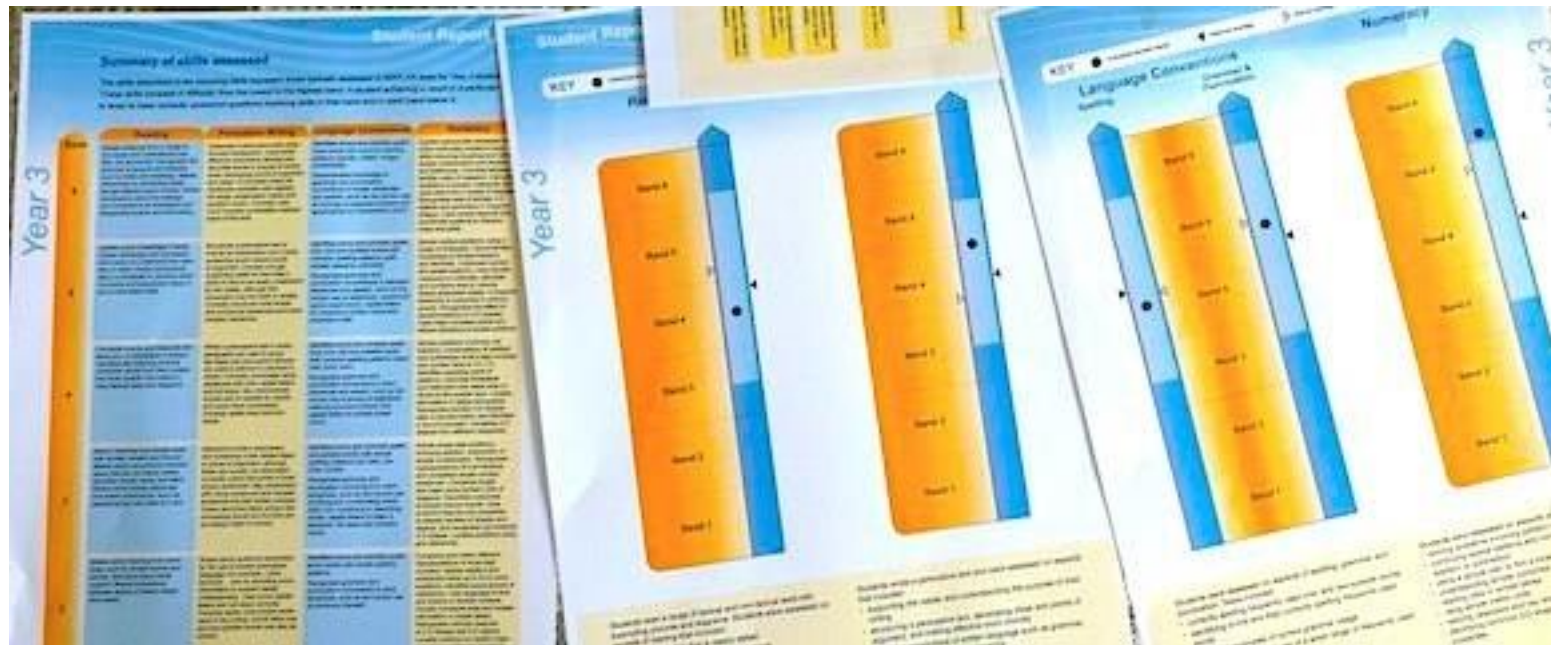
Midway through his HSC year, Adam Ma was given a game-changing study tip by a fellow physics student, who introduced him to flow charts. "I was shocked to see how simple it was when reviewing difficult content," he said.

Part of the class of 2018, Mr Ma achieved an ATAR of 98.4, but spent last summer wondering how much better he could have done had he sought more advice from his peers. "If I had known more tricks from top students, my marks could have been higher," he said.

To save this year's HSC cohort from the same lingering doubts, Mr Ma invited students who finished in the top 10 in the state for a particular subject last year to write about their most effective study tips for a book, *Catch Up With Top Achievers*.

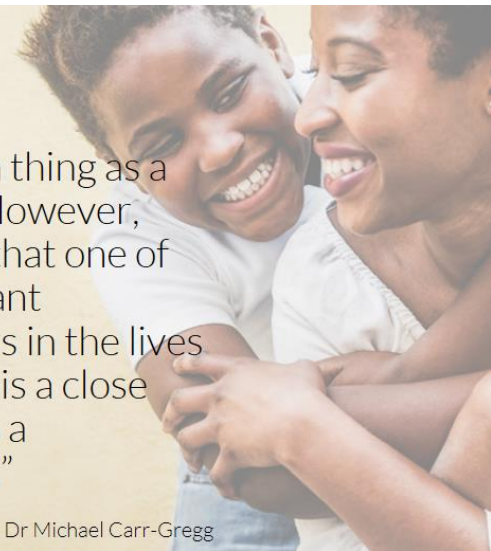


