Dear parents and carers,

We had an excellent evening meeting this month via Zoom. Thanks to those parents and community members who attended online, close to 25 people! We covered a number of topics:

- Attendance: We have a focus on attendance this year. Students should be attending school 100% of the time unless there is a medical issue.
- Literacy update: Morgan Howard, Head Teacher Literacy, provided an update on school literacy programs including the Premier's Reading Challenge, QuickSmart which is an intensive literacy and numeracy intervention program, WordFlyers which is an online literacy learning package and Education Perfect which is another online program. Year 7 students were recently given a book donated by the school to encourage reading at home. Our literacy and numeracy website (https://www.cecilhillshigh.nsw.edu.au/literacy-and-numeracy) has a wealth of resource to support students and parents at home.
- Feedback on C.E.C.I.L skills in reports: Parents indicated they liked the new report format including our C.E.C.I.L skills, focusing on communication, engagement, collaboration, innovation and leadership.
- **Education Week**: We celebrated Education Week by providing snapshots of the work completed by different faculties during our learning from home time.
- **Subject selection**: It is subject selection time for Year 8 and Year 10. The main pieces of advice are that students should choose subjects they enjoy, consider their future pathway and be guided by our experts at school.
- **Next meeting:** The next P&C meeting will take place at 6:30pm on Monday, 7 September 2020. These meetings are for us to share information with you and we benefit from these meetings just as much as you. Your presence and ideas are what we need.







English Faculty- Online Assessments, Marking and Feedback

- Students were able to be given traditional test papers, but electronically, they could then type, answers and were marked online, with feedback. Even in class teacher used google feature, where they could see what was being typed in real time and give immediate feedback.
- We also used our normal criteria, but in electronic form, with personalized feedback. All this meant that the important learning dialogue of assessment and feedback could continue in class and cross form.









Flipgrid is a website that allows teachers to create "grids" to facilitate video discussions. Each grid is like a message board where teachers can pose questions, called "topics," and their students can post video responses that appear in a tiled grid display.







Mark Sutton: On behalf of the staff and Parents of CHHS, we would like to welcome Julia Cremin to CHHS as an additional Deputy Principal.

Julian Cremin spoke about attendance for students. There will be more negative and Positive phone calls to parents concerning attendance of their child.

Morgan Howard – Literacy HT, spoke about Literacy across CHHS. Quicksmart is an app used. Morgan suggested, try setting up a library at home to encourage your child to read. Recommended reading time is 20 mins per night. Also, parents to check their child's diary.

Michael Lane – Deputy Principal, Asked parents for their feedback on the issue of the mid-year reports. Many parents are happy with the new layout. One concern was the issue of the report at 3pm on the last day of term. Parents feel that they should receive the report earlier in the week, so parents are able to contact teachers if needed.

Denise James – Deputy Principal, spoke about CECIL skills, how to receive your reports. Education Week 3-7 August. English faculty online assessments.

Stephanie Haskett – Deputy Principal – Explained how the English and Maths faculties have embraced online learning. Stephanie went through all the faculties and what platforms are used.

Mark Sutton – Subject Selection for years 7,8 and 10. 40% of year 12 go off to work/TAFE/other & 60% advance to University. Year 8 students pick subjects for fun and enjoyment, Year 10 choose subjects towards their career. Parents are advised to listen, guide and advise their child but in the end its their decision.

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GENERAL BUSINESS:

Year 12 Formal: Parents asked if the Formal was going ahead. They were advised that it may be moved to the end of the year due to the COVID19 restrictions, as there are more than 150 students. The P&C was asked if they could donate some money towards the year 12 graduation as have only fund raised once this year. The P&C has agreed to donate \$2000 to the 2020 year 12 and it will go towards their school graduation day. The P&C will also look into contacts who may be able to assist the students with decorations on the day.

Parents concerned about students smoking in the area between Elizabeth Hills & Cecil Hills. School has assured that students & Parents involved have been made aware.

Vaping in the school grounds have also been made aware to Executive Staff.
