## What Happened At P&C? – February 2019

Dear parents and carers

We had two excellent evening and daytime parent meetings this month. Thanks to those parents and community members who attended, close to 50 people! We covered a number of topics:

- **Year 7 Advisers:** Vivian Phan and Andrew Faga gave an overview of how Year 7 have settled into the school. Year 7 have made a great start to their high school education!
- **School expectations:** Denise James, Deputy Principal, ran an excellent seminar on a range of issues including attendance, uniform, social media and avenues of support. Parents are encouraged to monitor their child's use of social media and ensure they establish clear boundaries at home for the use of devices which includes checking them in with parents before children go to sleep.
- **Stymie:** A reminder that the Stymie website can be used to anonymously report bullying and other issues to the school: <https://www.stymie.com.au/>
- **Colour Run:** I provided a wrap-up of our *Colour Run* which raised more than \$10,000 to help 'cool the school' and explore options for air-conditioning classrooms.
- **HSC results:** I provided an overview of our excellent HSC results from 2018. This included 47 x Band 6 results (a mark over 90%), 266 x Band 5 results (a mark between 80% and 89%), an improvement in the school's HSC ranking, two students being placed on the HSC All Round Achievers List and a top ATAR of 98.50.
- **Year 7 (2019) BBQ + Year 7 (2020) Information Evening:** Both of these events will be held simultaneously on Monday, 25 February 2019.
- **NSW election BBQ:** We will be looking for parents to assist with a P&C BBQ on Saturday, 23 March 2019 as Cecil Hills HS is a polling booth.
- **Next meeting:** The next evening meeting will take place at 6:30pm on Monday, 4 March 2019 (which will be the P&C Annual General Meeting) and our daytime meeting will take place at 9:30am on Thursday, 7 March 2019. These meetings are for us to share information with you and we benefit from these meetings just as much as you. Your presence and ideas are what we need.

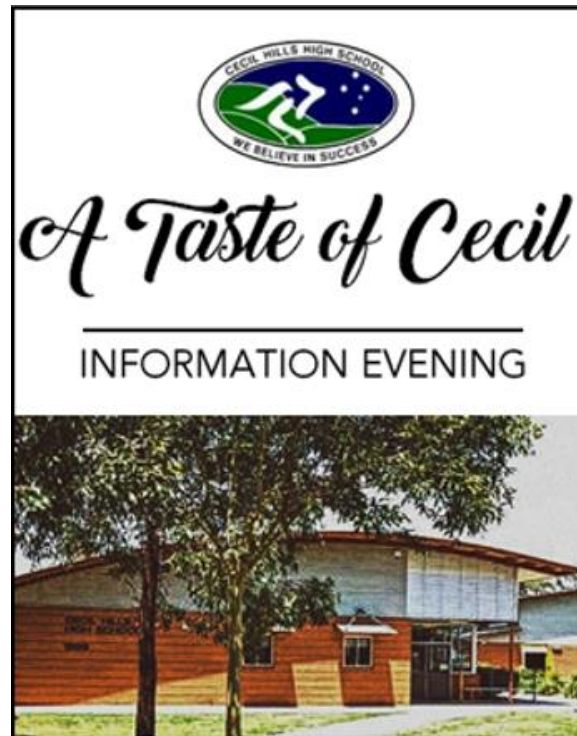

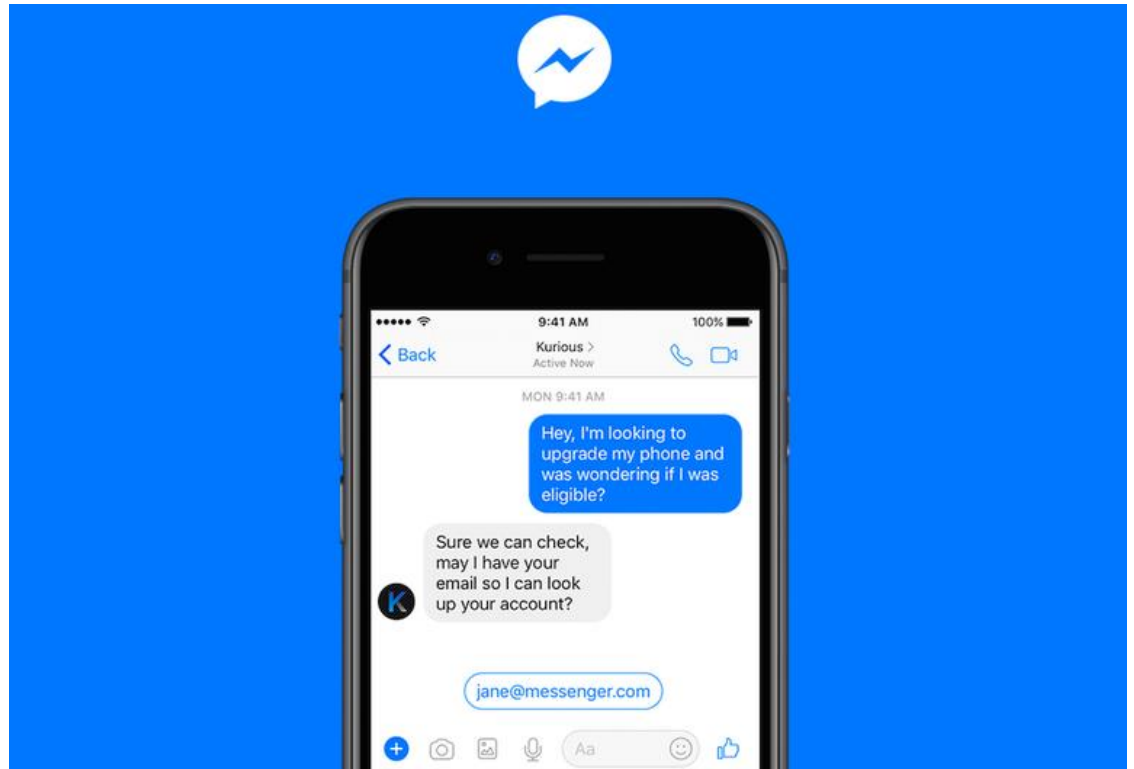


