What Happened At P&C? - September 2020

Dear parents and carers

We had an excellent evening meeting this month via Zoom. Thanks to those parents and community members who attended online. We covered a number of topics:

- Attendance: We have a focus on attendance this year. Students should be attending school 100% of the time unless there is a medical issue. We have some new school staff following up on attendance, in particular, for Year 7 and Year 8. You may receive a phone call from time to time from our school staff to help encourage the best possible attendance.
- Student Support Officer (Youth Worker): Welcome to Jonathan Brancati who is our new Student Support
 Officer. Jonathan comes to our school with experience in a similar role at another high school. His role
 includes taking some of the caseload off school counsellors, working with students and building connections
 with external agencies.
- **Tell Them From Me Survey**: Jane Carter, Head Teacher Professional Practice, provided an overview of this survey. We currently have around 9% of parents who have completed the survey and are aiming for many more voices to be heard. P&C members are asked to try to make contact with another five parents to ask them to complete the survey. This survey is important to help shape our future directions.
- **EAL/D Survey**: Stephanie Haskett, Deputy Principal, spoke about the EAL/D survey which will be sent to parents. Parents are asked to complete this survey so we can evaluate our work in this area.
- Strategic improvement plan: The school has started to write its situational analysis, which is the first step in creating our 2021-2024 strategic improvement plan. The first strategic direction will be 'student growth and attainment' and we will come back to the P&C with our other draft strategic directions at our next meeting.
- **Merit selection panels**: Parents who are able to serve on merit selection panels are asked to contact the school. During the year, we typically run around five merit selection panels to employ teachers and we are on the lookout for any new parents who might be willing to assist.
- **Uniform shop**: In the next week or so, the uniform shop will relocate to near the support unit. Parents are asked not to park on school grounds when accessing the uniform shop.
- Student leadership: Denise James, Deputy Principal, provided an overview of the process used to select our Year 12 captains, vice-captains and SRC representatives for Year 12 (2021). This involved an application, an online speech by applicants and a student/staff vote. We had a significant increase in the number of students seeking these formal leadership roles.
- **Next meeting:** The next P&C meeting will take place at 6:30pm on Monday, 2 November 2020. These meetings are for us to share information with you and we benefit from these meetings just as much as you. Your presence and ideas are what we need.

Thanks to everyone who logged into our meeting. I look forward to continuing to work with our parents and community members. Please let me know if you have any questions.



Attendance

- 200 school days each year
- 13 years of school education
- 2600 school days in total (200 x 13)
- 90% attendance = 2340 out of 2600 days

90% attendance means 260 days or 1.3 years of education would be missed


What is the Tell Them From Me Parent Survey?




The School Excellence cycle

A wellbeing platform for schools supporting parents


