

# Cecil Hills High School

Works notification | 13 June 2023

## Public domain works

A project to upgrade Cecil Hills High School is underway and will provide additional permanent learning spaces and core facilities to support the growing population in Western Sydney.

As part of the planning approval requirements for the upgrade, School Infrastructure NSW needs approval from Liverpool City Council for public domain works along Frederick Road and Spencer Road.

The proposed changes to the public domain will create a new entry point for the school to the new building. The changes have been designed to improve access to the school by foot, bicycle, scooter, and public transport and improve safety during student drop off and pick up times.

The public domain works will add:

- a 120m 'kiss and drop' zone on Frederick Road
- a new wombat crossing on Frederick Road
- a new school entry on Frederick Road
- pedestrian fencing along Frederick Road either side of the new crossing.

In addition, the works will involve:

- widening the existing path on the school side of Frederick Road to create a 2.5m wide shared pathway for pedestrians and cyclists along the new 'kiss and drop' zone
- a slight adjustment of the existing bus stops on Frederick Road (north and south)
- creating a 1.5m wide footpath on the corner of Frederick and Spencer Road
- changing the restricted parking zone on Spencer Road to a 'no stopping zone'.

The map overleaf shows the location of these works.

We expect the works to start in 2024 and will notify the community before they start.
