COVID-19 UPDATE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Dear parents and carers,

I would like to provide you with an update on my earlier communication. As indicated previously, a member of our school community tested positive for COVID-19. I have the following updates:

- Year 9: We have now separately emailed parents of Year 9 students who are close contacts. All other Year 9 students are no longer required to isolate.
- Year 11: As advised earlier today, our Year 11 students were isolated as a precautionary measure pending the outcome of a COVID-19 result. NSW Health advised today that the person concerned has tested negative to COVID-19. Year 11 students are no longer required to isolate.

Students are asked to be mindful of symptoms such as a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting or extreme tiredness. If your child develops any of these symptoms, please:

- Go to a COVID-19 testing clinic (see details below); and
- Call the school to let us know and keep your child at home until you receive confirmation that the test is negative or their symptoms have resolved, whichever is longer.

If you require an interpreter, please contact the Telephone Interpreter Service on 131 450 and ask for an interpreter in your language. You will not be charged for this service.

The safety and wellbeing of our staff and students is paramount at all times. As such, we will continue to work closely with NSW Health to ensure that all necessary health advice is closely followed.

While we recognise this can be disruptive and inconvenient for many families it is important that we follow NSW Health advice and take all necessary precautions to minimise the risk of further transmission within our community.
